## POINTS

Points will be allocated as previously but the exact number of points available in each section will be determined by the number of entries and will be announced after the first event. A competitor's best results will count up to a maximum of SIX completed rides.

## ENTRY FEES AND MARSHALLING

Competitors' performances will not be included in the League Table until they have paid the Series' entry fee. Senior / Veteran entrants will be required to "stand down" for one specified week to assist with the marshalling or administration duties. A full list of the marshals for the whole series will be published at the start of the Series. **If you are unable to marshal please notify The Organiser, Gavin Quayle on 430236 as soon as possible so as a replacement can be organised. Failure to conform will result in exclusion from the series.** A number of points equal to the maximum score gained during the series will be awarded to the Marshall on that week.

**\*\* Drafting is cheating and will result in disciplinary action. \*\***

Those competitors who wish to ride just one or a few events are required to be a member of a club affiliated to IOM Cycling and complete & sign a separate TLI Entry form as a Full Member for each event. A fee of **£12.00** (Youth **£10.00**), must be paid to the organiser before the start. Their performance will be included in the Series results provided they have also marshalled on at least one occasion as directed by the League Co-ordinator.
