

# **ISLE OF MAN COMMONWEALTH GAMES ASSOCIATION**

## **POLICY STATEMENT REGARDING STANDARDS AND SELECTION CRITERIA**

1. Selection Criteria should be open, transparent and defensible to athletes, should it be challenged.
2. In order to create a 'level playing field' across all sports, it has been agreed that selection standards should reflect an athlete's capability to reach the last 16 or quarter final in top competition within his chosen sport.

Where possible Sport standards should be relative to the agreed previous Commonwealth Games standards and not reduced; unless it can be argued that Sport IF rules have changed and a strong recommendation is proposed for a reconsideration to be made.

3. Participation in GB, or equivalent International, ranked competition must be encouraged and athletes should be able to demonstrate their ranking where such a ranking system is maintained.
4. All athletes must be encouraged to keep a diary of their events and results as a record of their commitment to improve ahead of team selection for a Commonwealth Games Team.
5. Athletes nominated for selection must complete a CV in the CGA approved format and justify their results by including an official results printout.
6. It should be understood that achievement of a standard is regarded only as an indication of performance and does not imply selection.
7. All athletes must satisfy the Eligibility rules as set down by the Commonwealth Games Federation.

# ISLE OF MAN COMMONWEALTH GAMES ASSOCIATION

## ELIGIBILITY

1. As a condition of entry to compete in the Commonwealth Games, all competitors must be citizens or subjects of the Commonwealth Country that enters them and must:
  - (a) Not be currently under disqualification or suspension by the Federation, or their respective Affiliated CGA or IF or under the World Anti-Doping Code;
  - (b) Comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the Federation, their respective IFs and the World Anti Doping Code as may be modified and applied by the Federation to ensure that the overriding principles of the Commonwealth Games are observed.
2. Where a competitor was born in a Commonwealth Country that has common citizenship/passport with other Commonwealth Countries, the competitor may initially represent either the competitor's Commonwealth Country of birth; or the Commonwealth Country of birth of his or her father or mother that shares the same citizenship/passport.
3. After having represented one Commonwealth Country at the Commonwealth Games, a competitor may not represent another Commonwealth Country unless he or she receives the approval of the Federation, the relevant IF and the Affiliated CGAs of the two Commonwealth Countries concerned.
4. It is the responsibility of all Affiliated CGAs to ensure that their competitors are fully aware of and comply with the eligibility rules of the Federation.

Eligibility for selection shall be in terms as set out in 'The Constitution of the Commonwealth Games Federation' under 'Eligibility' (presently Article 25) but modified for the Isle of Man selection purposes only as follows:-

- (a) A competitor must reach a standard as approved by the cycling directors (although this does not mean automatic selection);
- (b) Shall demonstrate that he or she have a close identity with the Island by reason of immediate family and normal residence and the prospect of feed-back into insular sport;
- (c) That under Article 24.1 of the Commonwealth Games Federation Constitution a citizen or subject of the Isle of Man is defined as a:
  - (i) Holder of a UK passport who has completed 5 years continuous residency immediately prior to the 'Entry by Name' cut-off date for the Games or;
  - (ii) Holder of a UK passport who was born on the Isle of Man.

(d) Any person gaining qualification as above and undertaking a programme of study, secondment or involved in military service out of the Island, shall be deemed a permanent resident for purposes of selection, provided he or she can demonstrate retaining an active connection with the Island.

### **Selection Procedure**

1. The consideration qualification window opened on 1 November 2015 and runs until 30 November 2017. The team will be selected on 15 February 2018.
2. Nominations for selection shall be submitted by the IOM CA, along with validated evidence of athlete performance during the selection period.
3. Nominations received will then be considered by the Council against the selection criteria and agreed specific event standards, following which governing bodies will be informed of selections and/or provisional selections and any specific conditions attaching thereto.
4. Athlete caps and quotas are now being introduced by the CGF for both Commonwealth Games and Commonwealth Youth Games. The IOM Team's Selection, when agreed by the Executive Council at the appointed general meeting, is therefore final and no right of appeal can be accommodated.
5. An athlete selected for an event on the basis of satisfying the agreed specific standard for that event may also be entered in other events at the discretion of the Council. In considering such other entries, the Council will take into account any likely detrimental impact on the athlete's performance in his/her selected event.
